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## CIRCULAR

Dear Parents,

As informed in the circular dated 14-03-2022, the Academic Year 2022-23 has begun on March 27<sup>th</sup> for Grades 10 and 12. Grades 3 to 9 will begin classes on April 3<sup>rd</sup> and LKG to Grade 2 will begin classes on April 4<sup>th</sup>.

**We reiterate that classes will be held online ONLY till April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022.**

Hybrid Classes will begin for the Academic Year 2022-23 on April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022. You are hereby requested to complete the Google Form linked in this circular to state your choice for mode of learning for your child latest by 7.00 p.m. on Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> April, 2022. If the form is not completed by the stipulated time we will assume that your child will be attending online classes.

**\*\*IMPORTANT\*\* - Your choice for mode of learning is applicable for the whole term (April to June) unless there is a change in policy from the concerned authorities. Changes to mode of learning mid-term will not be accepted.**

If more than 50% of the students of a particular section opt for in-person classes, students of that section will be divided into two batches, Batch A and Batch B and will be able to attend classes in person only twice a week. Batch A will attend on Sunday and Monday. Batch B will attend classes on Wednesday and Thursday. The whole class will attend online classes on Tuesdays.

**Please Note:**

- Transport cannot be provided to those children who opt for in-person classes.
- Students should reach the school before 7:45 a.m. and be collected no later than 1:30 p.m. Parents will not be allowed to pick up a student before 1:00 p.m., unless it is an emergency. In this case, prior information must be provided to the school office by calling beforehand.
- Students should come in perfect and neat school uniform. School lanyard with ID is compulsory.
- The canteen will be closed, hence it is necessary that students carry their own snacks and water.
- If your child is unwell, please do not send the child to the school. If a student is found to have a temperature of more than 37° C, they will not be allowed to enter school and attend classes for the day. If a student develops a temperature of more than 37° C during the course of the day, the parent will be informed and they must immediately come and pick up the student from school.
- Fee defaulters will not be allowed to attend in-person or online classes.
- All students are strictly required to follow all instructions of the staff and other outlined instructions.

Information regarding distribution of books will be given shortly.
